

1. The first two pews will remain vacant to eliminate distractions for players.
2. Each team is to have four members.
3. Each team may have an alternate player(s). After the 5<sup>th</sup> question in grades 1 - 7<sup>th</sup> & Teens or the 8<sup>th</sup> question in the adult rounds, the alternate can take the place of one of the other players on his/her team if they so desire.
4. Each question will be read twice.
5. Each answer will be read twice.
6. The correct answer will be "*the most nearly correct*" choice.
7. After the questions and answers have been read twice, the one asking the questions will ask the players to give their response. It is at this time the players are to flip switch A – B or C. Objections are to be made after answers are given so that the question/answer can stand if no discrepancies.
8. Score keepers will be appointed by the congregation sponsoring the Bible Bowl competition. Score sheets will be turned in at the end of each of the four rounds.
9. Ten points will be awarded for each correct response. A ten point bonus will be given if all four members of a team have the correct answer. (A perfect score for 1 round of 15 questions with 4 people answering all questions correctly including bonus points = 750 pts.)
10. After your points have been totaled by the score keepers, the one asking the questions will ask the players to reset their boxes. After this is done, we will go to the next question.
11. There will be four rounds of fifteen questions each for adults. (Highest points -- 4 rounds of perfect scores including bonus points = 3000 points). For grades 1 - 7<sup>th</sup> and teens (Grades 8 - 12<sup>th</sup>), there will be four rounds of 10 questions each.
12. After all teams have completed their four rounds, we will add the scores together.
13. Awards will be given to the first, second and third place teams in each division.
14. Up to eleven teams will be participating at the same time.



Grades 1 - 3 and Grades 4 - 7 will be given separate, more simplified questions relating to their level of competition.

The teens and adults will complete on their level with more difficult questions.

Final scores for each round of competition will be posted in the old Fellowship Hall of this part of the building on the bulletin board. You can check these at any time.
